Article 41.—Complaints and Responses

21-41-5. Manner of filing.

A complaint may be submitted for filing by delivery, mail, facsimile, or electronic mail to a commission office. If a complaint is received when the commission offices are closed, the complaint shall be considered received on the next business day that the commission offices are open.
