Kansas Board of Barbering

Article 1.—Sanitary Rules and Regulations Governing Barber Shops, Schools and Colleges and Public Rest Rooms in Connection Therewith

61-1-14. Mandatory use of neck strips, or towels, sanitary.

The hair cloth shall never be permitted to come in direct contact with the neck of the patron. Sanitary neck strips or towels must be used at all times necessary to prevent such contacts.
