Article 6.—Uniform Consumer Credit Code

75-6-32. Consumer Credit filing.

(a) Each consumer credit filer shall file notice with the administrator within 30 days after commencing business in Kansas and, thereafter, on or before August 31 of each year. The notice shall be submitted on a form provided by the administrator.

(b) If the consumer credit filer's name, status, or list of locations contained in the notification becomes inaccurate after filing, the consumer credit filer shall notify the administrator in writing within 30 days of the date of the change.
