Article 4.—Accident and Health Insurance

40-4-33. Same; standards for benefits; specified accident coverage.

"Specified accident coverage" means an accident insurance policy which provides coverage for a specifically identified kind of accident or accidents for each person insured under the policy for accidental death or accidental death and dismemberment combined, with a benefit amount not less than:

- (a) \$1,000 for accidental death;
- (b) \$1,000 for double dismemberment; and
- (c) \$500 for single dismemberment.
