Article 67.—Health Care Database

28-67-2. Health care database; information collected.

Information regarding various health factors shall be obtained. The health factors shall include, but not be limited to:

- (a) mortality and natality, including accidental causes of death;
- (b) morbidity;
- (c) health behavior;
- (d) disability;
- (e) health care costs and financing;
- (f) health care human resources;
- (g) health service utilization and availability;
- (h) environmental contaminants;
- (i) demographics;
- (j) familial social and economic conditions affecting health status; and
- (k) population-based health care outcomes.
