Article 3.—Preparation and Transportation of Bodies, Burial in Mausoleums and Funeral Establishments

63-3-12. Mangled, burned, and decomposed bodies.

Any body which is so badly mangled, burned, decomposed or partially decomposed that it cannot be prepared pursuant to K.A.R. 63-3-11 shall not be transported from a licensed funeral establishment until it is first thoroughly disinfected by a disinfecting compound or preservative and placed in a non-permeable container.
