

# **Kansas Administrative Regulations**

## **Department of Labor—Division of Employment**

### **Article 2.—Unemployment Insurance; Contributing, Reimbursing and Rated Governmental Employment**

#### **50-2-20. Notice of effective date of election or termination of reimbursing employer status.**

Any governmental entity, nonprofit organization or any group of nonprofit organizations identified in K.S.A. 44-710(e)(1), shall be notified by mail of the effective date of their election to become a reimbursing employer for a minimum period of four complete calendar years. An employer shall also be notified by mail of the effective date of the termination of the reimbursing employer payment option when applicable.

Employers terminating their reimbursing employer status shall remain liable for reimbursing payments until all wage credits on file as a reimbursing employer are no longer used in determining benefit entitlement.
