Article 32.—Testing Human Breath for Law Enforcement Purposes

28-32-13. Records.

(a)(1) Each agency custodian or the agency custodian's designee shall maintain the following records on file at the certified agency's office for at least three years:

(A) Records of each current certified operator;

(B) records showing that a quality control check was completed at least once each week for each EBAT device assigned to the agency; and

(C) records documenting any maintenance or repair made to each EBAT device.

(2) The records specified in this subsection shall be subject to inspection by the secretary at least annually.

(b) Each agency custodian or the agency custodian's designee shall maintain a record of the number of individuals tested by each certified operator under the certified agency's supervision.
