Kansas Department of Agriculture—Division of Animal Health

Article 9.—Poultry and Hatching Eggs

9-9-1. Poultry affected with, or exposed to, disease; importation prohibited.

Poultry which is infected with, or which has been exposed to, pullorum disease, typhoid disease, newcastle disease, fowl plague, chronic respiratory disease, fowl cholera, infectious bronchitis, laryngotracheitis, infectious sinusitis, fowl pox, coccidiosis, ornithosis, tuberculosis, or any other infectious or contagious disease, shall not be brought, shipped, or imported into the state of Kansas for any purpose whatsoever.
