Article 34.—Corporation Filing Fees

7-34-2. Corporation filing fees.

The fees for filing and issuing corporate documents shall be as follows:

Articles of incorporation:

- For-profit corporation: \$75.00
- Not-for-profit corporation: \$20.00
- Foreign entity application: \$100.00
- Restated articles of incorporation: \$20.00
- Certificate or agreement of amendment, correction, dissolution, merger, restoration, revocation of dissolution, or withdrawal, or any other certificate or agreement: \$20.00
- Name reservation: \$20.00
- Certificate of good standing: \$5.00
- Any other certificate issued by the secretary of state: \$20.00
- Certified copy of corporate filing: \$15.00
- Corrected instrument: a fee equal to the amount of the filing fee for the original instrument
