Kansas Corporation Commission

Article 4.—Motor Carriers of Persons and Property

82-4-35a. Inspections of motor carrier documents.

The following documents shall be made available upon request for inspection by any duly authorized representative of the commission, the state highway patrol, or other law enforcement officers:

- (a) Registration receipts;
- (b) authority cards;
- (c) driver logs;
- (d) bills of lading or shipping receipts;
- (e) waybills;
- (f) freight bills;
- (g) run tickets, or equivalent documents, and orders;
- (h) cab cards;
- (i) fuel receipts;
- (j) toll road receipts; and
- (k) any other documents that would indicate compliance with hours of service requirements.
