Article 17.—Miscellaneous

14-17-6. Acceptance of hospitality by the director; employees.

(a) Personal gifts to the director or any agent or employee of the director of liquor, money, services or any other thing of value from any manufacturer, distributor, wholesaler or retailer of alcoholic liquor, applicant for a license or licensee regardless of the dollar value of the item, shall not be allowed, except as provided for in subsection (b).

(b) The director, or any agent or employee of the director may, in the course of official business, attend conventions, seminars, workshops and other business meetings where food and drink are provided to the director, agent or employee as a participant.

(c) Each agent or employee shall receive prior approval from the director before attending a function where food and drink are provided free of charge or at a reduced cost.
