Article 35.—Radiation

28-35-227g. Records of planned special exposures.

(a) For each use of the provisions of K.A.R. 28-35-212f for planned special exposures, each licensee or registrant shall maintain records that describe the following:

- (1) The exceptional circumstances requiring the use of a planned special exposure;
- (2) the name of the management official who authorized the planned special exposure and a copy of the signed authorization;
- (3) any actions that were necessary;
- (4) the reason why the actions were necessary;
- (5) the precautions that were taken to ensure that doses were maintained ALARA;
- (6) the expected individual and collective doses; and
- (7) the doses actually received in the planned special exposure.

(b) Each licensee or registrant shall retain the records of a planned special exposure until the department terminates each pertinent license or registration requiring these records.
